ALOHA BIDDERS:

IN KEEPING WITH GOVERNOR IGE'S EMERGENCY DECLARATION REGARDING COVID-19, DAGS PUBLIC WORKS IS TEMPORARILY ALTERING THE PROCESS TO BE USED FOR BID OPENINGS TO ADHERE TO THE REQUIREMENT TO AVOID UNNECESSARY GATHERINGS.

AS OF JULY 6, 2020 THE KALANIMOKU BUILDING IS CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC WITHOUT PRIOR APPOINTMENT. THE HILO STATE OFFICE BUILDING IS ALSO CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC. THE DEADLINES FOR THE SUBMITTAL OF BIDS REMAINS AS POSTED ON OUR WEBSITE.

BID DROP-OFF ON OAHU

BIDS CAN BE DEPOSITED IN THE DROP BOX IN ROOM 426 OF THE KALANIMOKU BUILDING FROM 1:00 – 2:00PM ON BID OPENING DAY. PLEASE LEAVE THE BUILDING IMMEDIATELY AFTER DEPOSITING YOUR BID(S).

BID DROP-OFF ON HAWAII ISLAND

CALL 974-6400 TO ARRANGE FOR SOMEONE TO OPEN THE DOOR TO THE DAGS HAWAII DISTRICT OFFICE AND ACCEPT YOUR BID ENVELOPE.

AFTER 2:00 PM, BIDS WILL BE OPENED AND THE OPENING WILL BE WITNESSED BY SENIOR DAGS PERSONNEL.

AS IS NORMAL, FOLLOWING THE BID OPENING, THE BID TABULATION WILL BE POSTED ON THE DAGS PWD BIDDING SITE ON-LINE, ALONG WITH THE SUBCONTRACTOR LISTING FOR THE INITIAL APPARENT LOW BIDDER.

IN ADDITION, DAGS PWD WILL EMAIL TO EACH BIDDER PDF FILES PROVIDING SCANS OF ALL PAGES FOR EACH OF THE FOUR APPARENT LOWEST BIDS RECEIVED. THIS SERVICE IS INTENDED TO REPLACE THE PRIOR PRACTICE OF PERMITTING BIDDERS TO PHOTOGRAPH COMPETITORS' BIDPACKAGES.
